

Graffiti is a community wide problem that must be removed immediately when discovered. If the graphics are not removed, more will follow in the same area which only compounds the problem. Because of the necessity for quick action regarding this public blight, the Township requires the property owners remove any graffiti within a very short period of time.

Sec. 7-113. Defacement of property. (Property Maintenance Code)

No person shall willfully or wantonly damage, mutilate or deface any exterior surface of any structure or building on any private or public property by placing thereon any marking, carving or graffiti.

It shall be the responsibility of the owner to restore said surface to an approved state of maintenance and repair.
