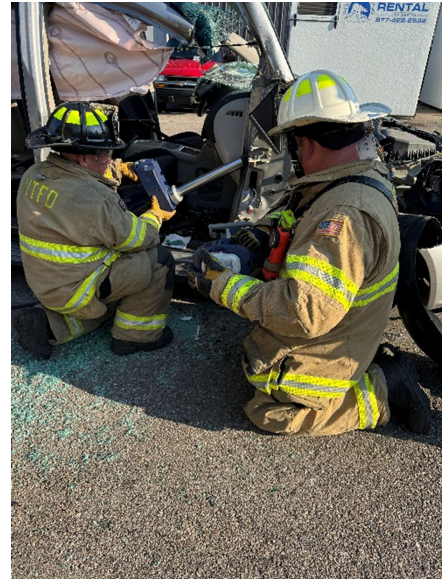
Apparatus, Equipment & Stations

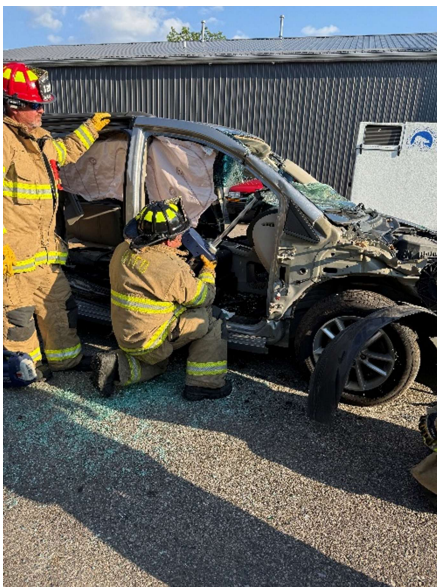
- Chief Tibbets met with neighboring Chief to discuss aid response

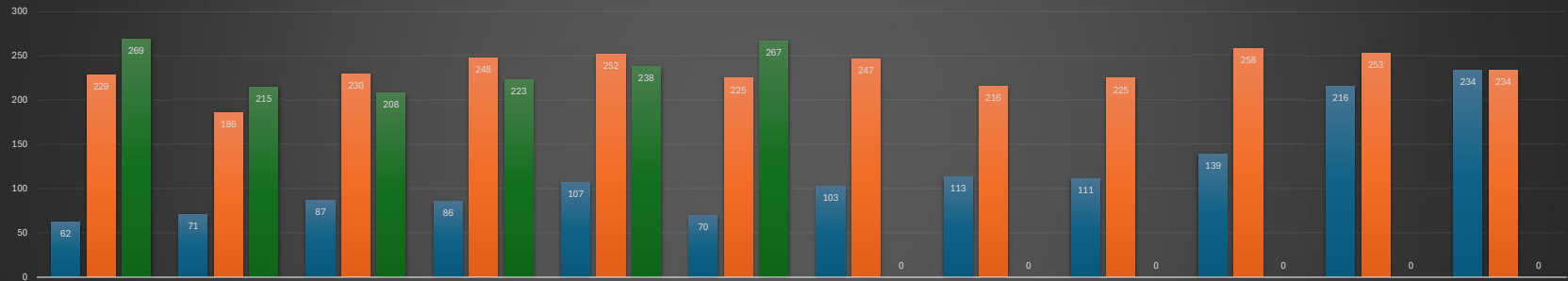

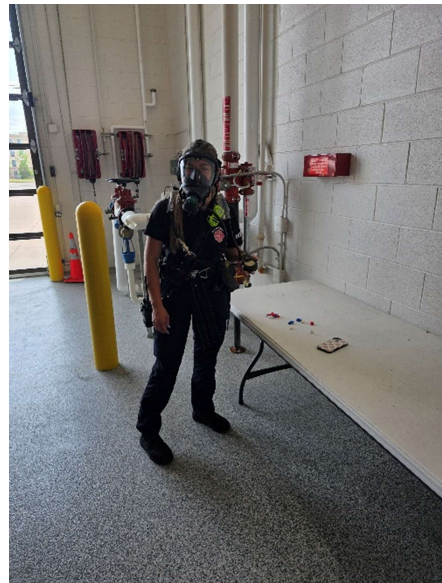

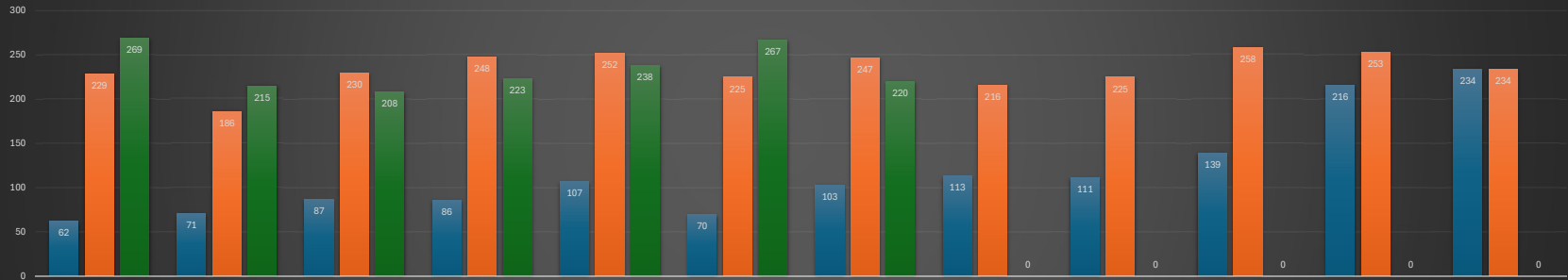
