After certain other matters of business were concluded, the Supervisor stated that the next order of business was the consideration of a request to conduct a speed study on 104th Avenue between Adams Street and Perry Street.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, concerns have been raised regarding current traffic speeds on 104th Avenue from Perry Street to Adams Street; and

WHEREAS, concern has been expressed about the negative impacts of current speeds on pedestrians, bicyclists and adjacent homeowners; and

WHEREAS, the posted speed limit changes within this segment which may create confusion for the motorist; and

WHEREAS, the Ottawa County Road Commission recently made the 104th/Perry intersection an all-way stop; and

WHEREAS, Holland Charter Township is required to request that the Michigan State Police, in conjunction with the Ottawa County Road Commission, conduct the desired speed study; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan State Police will gather speed and other engineering data to make a decision on the appropriate speed limit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Holland Charter Township that:

- 1. The Holland Charter Township Board of Trustees formally requests that the Michigan State Police conduct a traffic, engineering and speed limit study on 104th Avenue from Adams Street to Perry Street

- 2. It is understood that the Michigan State Police will use the data gathered from this study to make a decision which could raise the speed limit, lower the speed limit or keep the speed limit as it is

- 3. It is further understood that the Holland Charter Township Board of Trustees will abide by the decision made by the Michigan State Police as a result of this traffic, engineering and speed study
