

The following Amendment Ordinance was introduced and a first reading completed at the Holland Charter Township Board Meeting held on October 7, 2021.

BUILDING CODE AND FLOOD DAMAGE
PREVENTION AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 6 OF THE HOLLAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 6-29, TO AFFIRM AN ENFORCING AGENCY TO DISCHARGE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF HOLLAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP LOCATED IN OTTAWA COUNTY; AND CHAPTER 12 OF HOLLAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 12-8, TO DESIGNATE THE BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD.

THE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF HOLLAND CHARTER TOWNSHIP, OTTAWA COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Agency Designated. Section 6-29 of Article II, Chapter 6 of the Holland Charter Township Code of Ordinances, is restated in its entirety as follows:

Enforcing agency.

- (a) Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with section 8b(6) of Public Act No. 230 of 1972 (MCL 125.1501 et seq.), as amended, the building official of the township is designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the township.
- (b) Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, including the Michigan building code and the Michigan residential code, and in accordance with section 8b(6) of Public Act No. 230 of 1972 (MCL 125.1501 et seq.), as amended, the township assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the state construction code, including Appendix G of the Michigan building code, throughout its corporate limits.

Section 2. Designation of Regulated Flood Prone Hazard Areas. Section 12-8 of Article I, Chapter 12 of the Holland Charter Township Code of Ordinances, is restated in its entirety as follows:

The areas of special flood hazard are identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in a scientific and engineering report entitled "The Flood Insurance Study for Ottawa County, Michigan (all Jurisdictions)" effective October 21, 2021. This study, along with the accompanying flood insurance rate map (FIRM) panel numbers: 26139C0285E, 26139C0305E, 26139C0308E, 26139C0309E, 26139C0310E, 26139C0312E, 26139C0316E, 26139C0317E, 26139C0318E, and 26139C0319E effective December 16, 2011, and FIRM panel numbers: 26139CIND0C, 26139C0292F, 26139C0311F effective October 21, 2021 are adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this chapter and part of section 1612.3 of the Michigan building code, and declared to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of table R3O1.2(1) of the Michigan residential code. The flood insurance study, flood insurance rate maps and flood boundary-floodway maps are on file at the township offices at 3S3 North 120th Avenue, Holland, Michigan.

Section 3. Repeals. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Holland Charter Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, on _____, 2021, after introduction and a first reading on October 7, 2021, and publication after first reading as required by Act 359 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective on _____, 2021.
