

The following Zoning Amendment Ordinance was introduced and a first reading completed at the Holland Charter Township Board meeting on August 20, 2020.

ZONING MAP AMENDMENT ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE to amend certain portions of the Zoning Ordinance and Map of Holland Charter Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, for the purpose of adding certain lands to the R-1 Low Density Residential zoning district.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HOLLAND, COUNTY OF OTTAWA, AND STATE OF MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Rezoning to R-1 Low Density Residential District.

That the Zoning Ordinance and Map of the Charter Township of Holland, Ottawa County, Michigan, said map being incorporated by reference in the Zoning Ordinance for the Charter Township of Holland pursuant to Section 2.2 thereof, be and the same is hereby amended, changed and altered so that hereafter the lands hereinafter described shall be zoned as and included in the R-1 Low Density Residential zoning district on said Zoning Map. Said lands are described as being in the Charter Township of Holland, Ottawa County, Michigan, described as follows:

PART OF NW 1/4 COM S 890 30M 50S E 897.50 FT FROM W 1/4 COR, TH N OD 15M 468 E 294 FT, TH S 890 30M 50S E 95.12 FT, TH S 00 18M 35S W 294FT ALG E LI OF W 1/2 OF E 1/2 OF SW 1/4 OF NW 1/4, TH N 890 30M 50S W 94.88 FT ALG E&W 1/4 LI TO BEG. SEC 35 T5N R15W

Said lands are addressed as 11069 Mason Street, described more specifically as 70-16-35-100-064.

Section 2. Effective Date.

That the foregoing amendment to the Holland Charter Township Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Holland Charter Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, on _____, after initiation and a public hearing by the Planning Commission on August 11, 2020, as required pursuant to the Michigan Act 110 of 2006, as amended,

and after introduction and a first reading by the Township Board on August 20, 2020, and publication after such first reading as required by Michigan Act 359 of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective on _____, which date is more than 7 days after publication of the ordinance as is required by Section 401(6) of Act 110 of 2006, as amended, provided that this effective date shall be extended as necessary to comply with the requirements of Section 402 of Act 110 of 2006, as amended.
